9 ECHO PARK/CHILI PEPPER PARK/TEAR DROP PARK

Sir Gahad Lane & Sir Andred Lane

- Clap your hands inside the echo pavilion to hear the magic!

10 ENCHANTED HILL PARK

More than 20 acres of lush landscaping and shaded walking trails with pergolas and bench seating areas are scattered throughout this neighborhood.

- Explore the Japanese Koi pond and formal European rose garden with hedge labyrinth and castle watch tower.

11 FITNESS PARK

Round Table Boulevard

- This two and one-half acre park has various exercising stations to use on your daily walk or jog.
- Children's area has see-saws.

12 KING MARK PARK

King Mark Drive

- Benches and lawn space located here to enjoy views of the golf course.

13 POLSER PARK

Polser Road & King Arthur Boulevard

- Plentiful green space ideal for resting after a jog or stretching before a walk.
- Polser Road lined with trees, reduces traffic noise.

14 QUEEN ELIZABETH PARK

Queen Elizabeth Boulevard & Round Table Boulevard

- Benches and lawn space here to enjoy views of the golf course.

15 ROUND TABLE GREENBELT

Round Table Boulevard

- Park to enjoy views of the golf course.

16 ACADEMY PARK & COMMUNITY GARDEN

Sword Bridge Drive and Magic Mantle (behind Swordbridge Amenity Center)

- Garden to grow organic vegetables, herbs and flowers.

17 CASTLE PARK/TUNNEL PARK

Merlin Drive & Queen Guinevere Drive

- Encourages fantasy play and challenges children's physical fitness abilities.
- A painted Knights Round Table with elevated seating.
- Tunnels lead to four sections only accessible by tunnel or slides.
- Each tunnel section is its own play area with seating.
- Tunnels are covered with rubber to help prevent injuries and make it easier to crawl.
- Park entrance features decorative iron dragon lights.
- Park has swings and built-in seating around the playground.



18 TRAIN PARK

Holy Grail Drive, Merlin Drive, Lady Carol Lane

- Playground equipment is designed for all age groups including equipment that is ideal for ski training.
- Large shade trees with built-in seating.
- Home to many duck families and other birds.

* No swimming

19 HIDDEN PARK

Accessible from Lady DeVance and Queen Peggy Lane

- A row of bushes 'hides' the entrance to this park from Lady DeVance Lane.
- A sidewalk through the park makes it easier for children to walk to nearby Castle Hills Elementary.
- Playground equipment includes: jungle gym, modern day see-saw and a moving trolley to evoke teamwork.

20 STONY PARK

Stony Passage Lane

- Features playground with equipment for different age groups and seating areas throughout park.

21 BERNDT PARK

Maris Street & Elsa Avenue

- Playground equipment serves two different age groups from 2 to 12 years old.
- Large shade trees with built in seating.
- Ties into the hike and bike trail.

22 DRAGON PARK

Merlin Drive & Sir Ector Lane

- One of Castle Hills first parks featuring a fire-breathing dragon peeking its head up out of the ground, with its tail waving behind.
- Dragons tail provides built-in seating area in the shade with other seating throughout park.
- Playground was built to encourage creative play and the ground surfaces researched to minimize the effect of falls.



23 FIRE TRUCK PARK

King Lionel Lane

- Large playground area featuring a fire truck and playground equipment with cabana roofs giving children a break from the sun.

24 PIRATE SHIP PARK/ SIR ASTAMORE PARK

Sir Astamore Lane & Sir Turquin Lane

- Playground equipment serves more than three different age groups between 2 to 15 years old.
- Playground games and equipment challenge children's physical fitness abilities.

25 WINDSOR PARK

Windsor Castle Way

- Playground equipment evokes imaginative play, shaded seating areas.

26 SLIDE PARK

Almsbury Lane

- Playground features colorful slides, shaded seating and ample space for children to play.

27 LAKE AVALON PARK

Lady of the Lake Boulevard & King Arthur Boulevard

- This 12-acre park features broad expanses of lawn, lake with fountains, a boardwalk and island area which make this spot fun for fishing, biking or picnicking.
- Site of community events. 4th of July event, Easter egg hunt, etc.
- Lookout Point is located on the south side of the lake with beautiful views of the park.
- Catch and release fishing is allowed with freshwater permit from Texas Parks and Wildlife. Call 800-895-4248 for more information.

* No swimming

28 CORNER LAKE PARK

Lady of the Lake Boulevard & Round Table Boulevard

- Pond provides water for golf course irrigation.

* Non-potable water, no fishing and no swimming

29 SILVER POND

Silver Table Drive

- Pond and park with walking trail, gazebo, pergola and fountain.

* Private park for Enchanted Hill residents only. No swimming

30 MERLIN'S PONDS

Either side of Merlin Drive near Sir Castor Court

- Two ponds and two lakeside seating areas with pergolas to enjoy views of the golf club.

* No swimming



31 BOOT LAKE PARK

Accessible from Crown of Gold Drive & Hundred Knights Drive & Adventurous Shield Drive

- Castle Hills hike-and-bike trail continues to wind around this lake connecting to the golf course.
- Large trees, fountains, lake, shade arbor and green space make this a tranquil gathering area for residents.

4 SWORD BRIDGE AMENITY CENTER

701 Sword Bridge Drive

- Junior-size Olympic pool with slides, a kiddie water play area and splash park, beach entry and tanning ledge.
- An adjacent playground to the pool serves more than three different age groups between 2 to 15 years old.
- Shaded pergola with lounging chairs and an abundant amount of picnic space.
- Includes: Castle Hills on-site mail facility and restrooms.

5 WEST AMENITY CENTER

2010 Joyous Circle

- Pool with a kiddie play area.
- Shaded pergola with lounging chairs.
- Includes: fitness room and restrooms.
- Partially covered playground area.



6 NORTHEAST AMENITY CENTER

700 Proud Knight Lane

- Pool with slide and shaded pergola with lounging area.
- Includes: banquet room, fitness facility, and restrooms.
- Partially shaded playground adjacent to the pool.

7 RETREAT POOL

Damsel Cherry Lane & Grail Maiden Court

- Includes lounging chairs and fire pit for year-round enjoyment.

* Private pool for Retreat residents only

8 LADY BETTYE AMENITY CENTER

Lady Bettye Drive

- Includes: pool, fitness room and restrooms. Traditional playground equipment with swings, clubhouse tower with slides, climbing dome, and a merry-go-round.
- Shaded seating areas.
- 5 piece ninja warrior course includes cargo net and rope climbs, ledge crawls, and quintuple jumping steps.



VILLAGE SHOPS & PLAZA

2500, 2520, 2540, 2560 King Arthur Boulevard

- Castle Hills Village Shops includes restaurants, boutiques and retail shops that cater to resident needs. From doggie day care to dry cleaning, the Castle Hills Village Shops is your one-stop shopping destination.

- The Plaza is an urban-style park, complete with shaded picnic tables, ample shaded seating areas, and sunken waterfall. Bring lunch and stay a while.

- There's even a stage and lounge area to discover during frequent community events, like the July 4th Freedom Festival, Fall Festival and annual tree lighting event, Holiday in the Plaza.

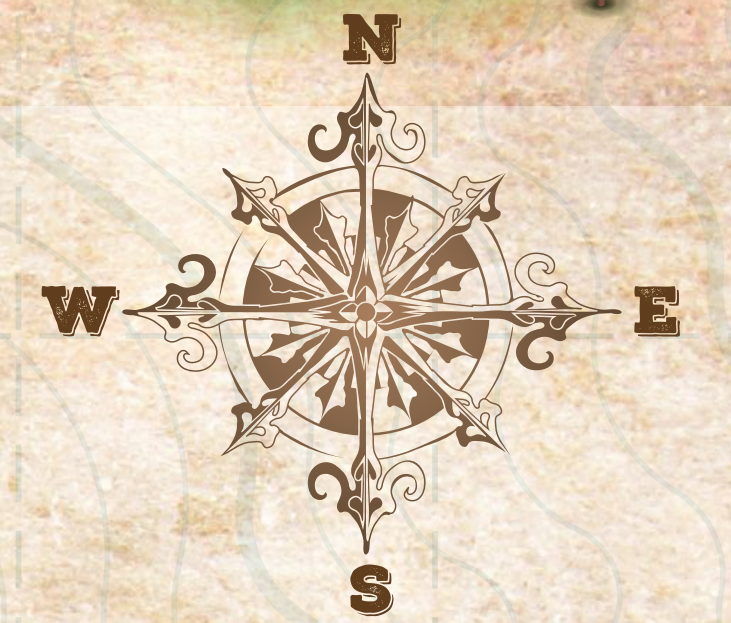
- Parks and Sports Fields close at dusk.
